



As we approach the Memorial Day Holiday weekend, it is a good time to remind residents that when you are mowing your lawn, it is illegal to deposit grass clippings or debris onto the roadway:

- Grass clippings on the roadway can create driving hazards for bicyclists and motorcycles and creates slippery conditions for vehicles.
- Grass clippings can clog storm drains and get washed away by stormwater.
- Grass clippings release nitrogen into water systems, which isn't healthy for the ecosystem or water system.
- If you accidentally deposit any debris or clippings onto the street, you are required to promptly remove them from the roadway.
- As a Kingston Township resident, you are able to bag or place clippings in a container and drop them off at our compost site.
- A small change in your lawn maintenance routine can save a life!

Also, a reminder that the Township Administrative Office and Public Works Department will be closed on Monday, May 27<sup>th</sup> in observance of Memorial Day.
