### Improved Safety Measures at Compost Site Exit

Kingston Township has accepted a proposal from Tri-Boro Fencing contractors to replace and relocate the chain link fencing at the compost site exit. This decision was made to address safety concerns and enhance visibility for vehicles leaving the site.

The Township's Public Works Department road crew will first remove the existing fence with their exceptional expertise, ensuring the area is prepared for the upcoming improvements. Following this, Tri-Boro Fencing will install a 220 foot new chain link fencing at each gate to provide a safer and more efficient exit with an improved line of sight.

This project underscores Kingston Township's commitment to maintaining safe and accessible facilities for all residents.

## Kingston Township Receives Recognition and Shares Project Updates

At the December 11th Supervisors Meeting, three heartfelt thank-you letters was read aloud highlighting Kingston Township's dedication to service. Young Ye Park expressed appreciation for the Department of Public Works, Chief Williams of the Jackson Township Police Department commended Officers Fuches, Carter, and Schaszberger for their invaluable assistance, and the Back Mountain Memorial Library extended gratitude for the Township's generous donation.

In addition to these acknowledgments, updates were provided on several exciting construction projects. The long-awaited water line installation at Center Street Park is set to begin in the coming weeks, weather permitting. Meanwhile, the East Franklin Street Bridge project is on track to start in February or March, following a bid opening this month to address the water main removal. Looking ahead to this Spring, construction on the Harris Hill Road Bridge is expected to kick off as engineers complete the final design work.

#### Center Street Park Moves Forward

Kingston Township has accepted the engineering and grant management proposal from Benesch Engineering for Phase 3 and Phase 4 improvements at Center Street Park. This project will focus on creating a more inclusive, accessible, and enjoyable space for residents and visitors.

### Winter Parking Ordinance in Effect Until March 31st

A friendly reminder that the Winter Parking Ordinance remains in effect through March 31st, 2025. Parking on Township streets is prohibited between 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM and during snowstorms (plus 8 hours after a storm ends).

Violators may be fined, so please ensure your vehicle is off the streets during these times to help with snow removal and keep roads safe. Thank you for your cooperation!
