2. Discussion on the Oath of Office to be administered by Board of Supervisors Chairperson, Thomas Ketchner for Alexander Kepp to serve as a member of the Special Fire Police through the Trucksville Volunteer Fire Company. Mr. Kepp has been confirmed by the Township Manager, effective June 4, 2025.
