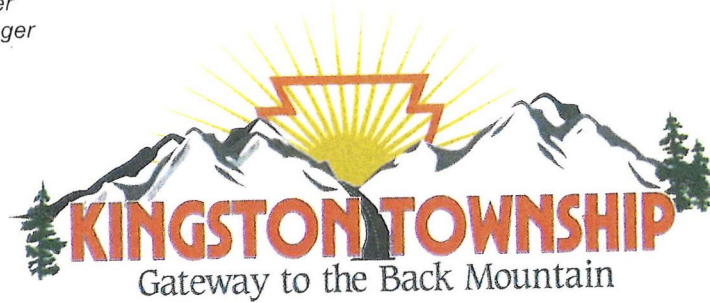

Kingston Township will be conducting its annual Spring Clean-Up **Thursday, May 7, 2026 from 7AM to 7PM; Friday, May 8, 2026 from 7AM to 7PM and Saturday, May 9, 2026 from 8AM to 2PM**. The clean-up will be conducted at the Kingston Township Public Works Facility located at 225 East Center Street in Shavertown, PA 18708.

CONTRACTORS REQUIREMENTS

The contractor shall agree to be on call and available for the removal and immediate replacement of containers, Thursday, May 7, 2026, Friday, May 8, 2026 from 7am to 7pm and Saturday, May 9, 2026 from 8am to 2pm during the clean-up hours.

All containers should be in good condition and transfer equipment shall be in working order. The contractor is responsible for obtaining any and all permits required by Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, with respect to solid waste and specifically, transfer stations for disposing of all wastes in accordance with the Solid Waste Management Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection and Luzerne County. The contractor shall be responsible for all payments to local landfills for tipping fees. The contractor shall be responsible for compliance with Luzerne County Solid Waste disposal site regulations and providing proof thereof.

Contractor shall submit a valid liability and auto insurance certificate on the fleet of vehicles used in the clean-up operation. The contractor must comply with Federal CDL licensing and drug and alcohol testing requirements applicable to drivers making deliveries to Kingston Township. The contractor assumes full responsibility for complying with Federal and State requirements.

The contractor shall be responsible for coordinating clean-up activities with the Township's Road Superintendent, Todd Chamberlain. Road Superintendent may be contacted at 570-855-2250.
