BUSINESS

1. Discussion on the Public Hearing for Ordinance O-2026-3 Chapter 15, Motor Vehicle Part 4- General Parking Regulations to be more consistent, up to date and consider handicapped parking permit request/s.
2. Discussion and review of the 2025 Financial Audit Report as completed by Rainey & Rainey Certified Public Accountants.
3. Open the sealed Bids for the Kingston Township Public Works Building Roof Replacement Project. Bid tabulation, review and award suggestion to be completed by Sobeck Roof Consulting and bid to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder at the Regular Supervisors' Meeting on August 12th.
